

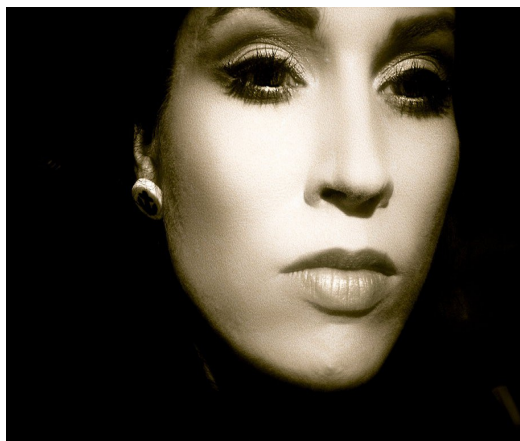

All songs are performed with backings by vintage singer Miss Noelle Vaughn, who sings them and performs them with sumptuous golden age Hollywood glamour in 1940s day outfit or WAAF uniform. Noelle knows well her repertoire and what she is singing about.

With a very well chosen repertoire and a most interesting preparatory work from the team, the WW2 Radio Days Project creates a most stimulating opportunity for students to approach to understanding of society, art, culture and fashion of the Second World War period.
