TWO PACKAGES

Radio Days Band. With a line up of saxo/clarinet, guitar, drums, double bass and voice, in costume. Making you sing and dance with us and offering an international perspective with songs from Italy (Tornerai) Mexico (Amapola) France (Adieu Venise Provençale) or Cuba (El Manisero).

Singer and backing tracks. Many of the backing tracks for this era are old 78 rpm recordings digitally restored and adapted to the singer's voice. Listen to examples in your website. This performance is ideal together with music and backings from the Roaring Twenties, and both parts can be performed in costume.
