## A selection of popular songs from 1914 to 1918



At this time of commemoration of the Great War, Radio Days is delighted to present a programme of music-hall songs, 'recruitment' songs, and soldiers' songs from the war years, including "Oh, It's A Lovely War", "Keep The Home Fires Burning", "I'll Make A Man Of You", "It's a long way to Tipperary", and "Sister Susie's Sewing Shirts For Soldiers", together with popular songs from the home front such as "Lloyd George's Beer" and "If You Were The Only Girl In The World".

This entertaining show, performed in period costume, is offered in three formats, as well as themed packages, with narrator, that include 'The Christmas Truce' and 'Jingoism and Recruitment in Music Hall'.

### THREE FORMATS

**Singer with piano soundtracks.** With our vintage 1919 Academy gramophone bringing atmosphere to the event, this is a very original package for smaller venues or limited budgets.

**Singer with 'live' classical piano or keyboards.** With either of our pianists, Dylan Keeling or Sharona Joshua. When the venue already has a piano we may use this (but we would need to check it prior to the concert), or bring our own.

**Singer with a very special piano.** A Pleyel piano, played and owned by Sharona Joshua, an original French instrument from 1853. Pleyel pianos are known for their round, warm and sensual sound, and would have been found in many homes during Edwardian times. A unique opportunity for a special event.
